- 1. AALT Updates.
 - a. Face coverings Beginning June 29th face covering will be required on campus for faculty, staff and students. It will be a requirement in all common areas on campus. There are still questions of how and who will be enforcing this new guideline.
 - b. Courses Missing Books COBA has the largest number of courses without books at this time. The Dean encouraged the Chairs to make sure all of their faculty have made their submissions.
 - c. Fall 2020 Semester.
 - i. Hybrid Schedule The Dean has to submit COBA's fall hybrid schedule to the Provost by July 1st.
 - ii. Email Update An email update will be sent the students soon with all of the current changes to the fall semester.
 - d. Task force against Racism The university has put together a task force in response to the current events involving racism. A training will be put out and panel discussion formed to help open dialog on hard topics.
 - e. Phase III.
 - i. Telecommuting Forms All staff that will continue to telecommute must submit a new form before July 1st.
 - ii. Buildings All buildings in campus will be open from 8 am to 5 pm.
 - iii. Dean's Office Rotation The current rotation of the administrative staff at the front desk in the Dean's Office will remain the same until August 1st.
 - f. Virtual Graduation The original plan for virtual graduation has remained the same except for one addition. Each college will have 10 to 15 faculty members record a zoom meeting of them clapping and supporting the graduates. Also, several will have the opportunity to make a recorded speech. The Dean will send out an email asking for volunteers.
