- 1. Approval of Minutes from September 18, 2015. The minutes were modified and approved.
- 2. <u>Curriculum.</u> The Leadership Team approved three new courses to be forwarded to the curriculum committee. The curriculum report is due on Monday. ## 7. Update from AALT.
