Teaching effectiveness ratings are weighted averages and should be recorded to the nearest tenth. Ratings by the students and chair should be weighted equally (each comprises 50% of the teaching activity score). the remaining activity areas are each to be evaluated as a whole. For example, scholarly and/or creative accomplishments (FES 3) should be evaluated and assigned an overall rating from 1 to 5.
