\*SHSU accepts a maximum of 70 credit hours: 66 academic hours + 4 hours of activity-based physical education (kinesiology) hours.

Students must earn a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in all coursework, overall major GPA, SHSU GPA, and SHSU major GPA.

A minimum 3.00 GPA is required for the MSAT application and a grade of C or higher in all required prerequisites.

1 - BIOL 1406, BIOL 2403, BIOL 2404, and CHEM 1411 satisfy the Core Curriculum requirement for Component Area III (Life and Physical Science). BIOL 1406, BIOL 2403, BIOL 2404, and CHEM 1411 are required prerequisites for the MSAT program and require a grade of "C" or higher. BIOL 2401 and BIOL 2402 may be used as transfer courses for the BIOL 2403 and BIOL 2404 requirements; please see a SAM Center advisor for more details.

2 - SOCI 2319 is recommended and satisfies the Core Curriculum requirement for Component Area IV (Language, Philosophy, and Culture). SOCI 2319 is a recommended (not required) prerequisite for admission to the MSAT program.

3 - PSYC 1301 satisfies the Core Curriculum requirement for Component Area VIII (Social and Behavioral Sciences). PSYC 1301 is a required prerequisite for the MSAT program and requires a grade of "C" or higher.

4 - COMS 1361 satisfies three semester credit hours and KINE 2115 satisfies one credit hour of the Core Curriculum requirement for Component Area IX (Component Area Option).
