## **COBA LEADERSHIP TEAM MEETING MINUTES** Friday, May 11, 2012

- 1. <u>Approval of Minutes from April 13, 2012.</u> The minutes were modified and approved.
- 2. CAD Items.
  - a. Dean Searches. A new dean has been selected for the College of Sciences. Dr. Mary Robbins will continue to serve as interim dean for one year.
  - b. Policy Changes. The Faculty Development Leave policy is being rewritten. It was suggested to let the dean of each college decide who should receive a faculty development leave. There is a new policy on patents and copyrights.
  - c. Master Plan Update. The Nursing and Agriculture programs are top priorities.
  - d. Merit. If increases in tuition are approved at the Board Meeting, the President's highest priority is faculty and staff merit.
- 3. <u>Research Park.</u> A new director will be hired for Research Park. Jerry Cook will be chairing that search committee. SBDC will relocate there and a version of the Sower Technology Lab will be there too. CMIT/LEMIT will also relocate to Research Park.
- 4. <u>Distance Learning Course Evaluations.</u> Dean Muehsam will be meeting with Bill Angrove next week in regards to online course evaluations.
- 5. COBA Retreat Items.
  - a. FES. Should scores for online classes be treated differently than those from face-to-face classes?
  - b. DLF Funds. The Dean asked the chairs to think of ways to best utilize DLF funds.
- 6. Miscellaneous Items.
  - a. HEAF funds. There is approximately \$35,000 left in HEAF funds. Accounting requested funds for a new copier.
  - b. Enrollment Management requested each of the colleges provide brochures for the 4,500 prospective students that will be attending 26 camps this summer. COBA will work on a one page information sheet about the BBA from SHSU.
  - c. Smith-Hutson students. Forty-five students were interviewed for Smith-Hutson scholarship program and thirty-two students received scholarships.
  - d. Grade Entry. There is no option for an incomplete for graduate courses. Please send Dr. Valerie Muehsam an email and she will let the Registrar's office know.
